Workshop: « EuroMed Youth Praxis regarding intercultural dialogue»

What are «good practices »?:

They are examples of procedures or methods that have good results. A good practice is one approach – sometimes innovative- that experiments and evaluates in order to achieve a good result.

The term "good practice" also implies the reproduction and dissemination of such methods.

<u>In other words, you can call a good practice – an action or method that has been realised, that has been fruitful, and that can be reproduced in other contexts (European and Mediterranean in this case).</u>

Synopsis:

This working group will be used to disseminate good practices throughout the youth in European and Mediterranean countries in the context of intercultural dialogue.

In fact, regarding the individual EuroMed countries we can see that good practices already exist and that they begin with youth working in the field of intercultural dialogue, but for lack of information and effective communication they cannot be adopted in different countries.

The workshop will permit an evaluation of good practices to be realised by youth in the context of intercultural dialogue in EuroMed countries and will open up a new space for exchange of opinions, reflections, and the creation of future projects.

A document cataloguing the good practices suggested by the participants from each country and how they can be adapted to different contexts within the Euro-Mediterranean region will be realised and presented to the Minister of Foreign Affairs and other international bodies.

Objectives of the workshop:

- 1) Listing of the good practices realised by the youth in the context of intercultural dialogue in their countries (preparatory work must be prepared by each participant)
- 2) An exchange of good practices and an analysis of the possibilities to adapt these good practices in other contexts within EuroMed sphere.
- 3) Dissemination of good practices relating to intercultural dialogue used by youths in Europe and South Mediterranean countries.

Preparatory work:

- 1) Create a list of good practices (between 1-3): The participants must research into at least one or more good practices relating to the intercultural dialogue realised by youths in their country (it is possible to choose a good practice realised by their own organisation, if appropriate)
- 2) For each good practice described above, the participants must complete the document <u>FICHE_BONNE_PRATIQUE.doc</u>, describing in as much detail as possible.
- 3) Collect as much information as possible (descriptions, photos, power-point, articles etc.) relating to the good practices described above. This will be used to support the workshop.
