



MAIN ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA Applicants and Partners

Only the following countries have adhered to the Programme:

EU Member States: Cyprus, France, Greece, Italy, Malta, Portugal, Spain,

Mediterranean Partner Countries*:

Egypt, Jordan, Israel, Lebanon, Palestine and Tunisia.

* In order to fully participate, the MPCs must sign a FA with the EC

Main participation criteria



- WHO: Ministries, Regional/Local Authorities, NGOs, SMEs; Associations; Universities; National Authorities; International Organisations etc.
- Geographical eligibility : <u>Applicants</u> must be located in eligible¹ regions
- Partners can be located in <u>eligible and adjoining</u>* regions

Applicants and PPs based in Lisbon region may apply only under the Over. Objective 1
* According to the financial limitations



Specific Requirements

- ✓ IOs can apply as Applicant or PPs <u>only</u> if having an <u>operational office in eligible territories</u>
- ✓ Ministries and national PAs <u>should</u> implement activities through <u>local offices</u>
- Participation of partners from <u>adjoining regions</u> assessed <u>on a case by case</u> basis considering its added value, <u>max 20% of project direct costs</u>

Exclusion situations



1) Exclusion situations foreseen by Art. 45 of the ENI IR making reference to Art. 106(1) and 107 of Financial Regulation 966/2012: bankruptcy, fraud and corruption, conviction, conflicts of interests, misrepresentation, etc.

- 2) Specific exclusion situations:
- failure to reimburse sums to the EU
- attempts to obtain confidential information or to influence the selection process

Specific financial requirements

- ✓ Compliance with State Aid provisions for EU organisations (art. 12, ENI IR) <u>de minimis</u> approach
- ✓ At least <u>50% of the total direct costs</u> to be dedicated to activities <u>implemented</u> in the MPCs, i.e.:
 - a) <u>allocation</u> of min. 50% of direct costs <u>to MPC</u> partners

or

b) the difference up to minim. 50% shall be justified by <u>activities implemented</u> by the EU PPs <u>in MPCs</u>



Specific Limitations of this Call

- Applicants can submit <u>only 1 proposal</u> for each priority. No limitations for participation at partner level
- ✓ Max <u>35%</u> of total <u>direct costs</u> (d.c.) to be <u>allocated to a single organisation</u>, except if there is only one partner from a MPC, which might manage max 50% of the total d.c.



Project Eligible Costs

- ✓ Eligibility criteria of costs as foreseen by art. 48-49 of ENI IR (Reg. 897/2014)
- ✓ Procurement rules regarding goods, works and services needed for the project implementation as per artt. 52 to 56 of ENI IR and artt. 8-9 of ENI CIR (Reg. 239/2013) for the rule of nationality and origin





Project eligible costs

WHAT

- 1. DIRECT COSTS
- Preparatory costs (max 10.000 travel/subsistance)
- Human resources (simplified)
- Travel / subsistence (simplified)
- Infrastructures (env. Impact assessment >1 MI)
- Equipment and supplies
- Subcontracted Services
- Other costs (Subgrants max 30% total direct cost)
- 2. INDIRECT COSTS
- Contingency reserve (3% optional)
- Administrative costs (up to 7%)

No profit principle!





One stage submission: main features



Project proposal submitted in one stage (Full Application Form, Logical Framework, Budget and Financial Plan and Declarations). Simplified formats and electronic features.



Two step evaluation process:

1. Relevance and quality of design

 Operational and financial capacity of partnership, (Relevance score transferred from step 1), Effectiveness, Sustainability, Budget



100% paperless application: application filled in and submitted online (including upload of mandatory declarations)
