- ✓ Contributing , with this regional effort, to the wider context of the UN Sustainable Development agenda;
- ✓ Setting in place regional dialogue, stakeholders involvement and launch of concrete actions in areas of common interest.



Work as **Stakeholder register and Networking platform** bringing together knowledge and experiences for cross-fertilization and collaboration

Promote its role as a <u>regional hub</u> on blue economy bringing together information and data through the contribution received by stakeholders

Promote its role as <u>communication tool</u> by disseminating information of the organization of conferences/meetings/seminars as well as information on policies developments, projects milestones and results etc.

3) UfM Regional Stakeholder Conference on Blue Economy

OBJECTIVE: ...promote discussion and exchanges amongst UfM stakeholders on developing a sustainable blue economy in the Mediterranean....and an opportunity to take stock of progress made in the implementation of the 1st UfM Ministerial Declaration on the Blue Economy...

Call for Thematic Stakeholder Workshops

The themes of the workshops, as well its format, will be proposed by the blue economy stakeholders. Each workshop will deal with topics relevant to blue economy in the Mediterranean seabasin, in line with the priorities of the UfM Ministerial Declaration, such as:

- ✓ Marine research and innovation;
- ✓ Education, training and skills development in the maritime domain;
- ✓ Business development (maritime clusters, start-up, boosters, etc.) and investment (access to finance) in the blue economy;
- ✓ Maritime transport safety and security, and sustainable ports;
- ✓ Sustainable aquaculture and fisheries, including small scale fisheries and coastal communities development;
- ✓ Coastal and maritime tourism and marinas;
- ✓ Maritime Spatial Planning and Integrated Coastal Zone Management;
- ✓ Renewable marine energies;
- ✓ Sustainable consumption and production in the blue economy;
- ✓ Marine and coastal environment protection (including Marine Protected Areas), marine pollution (including marine litter).

Call for Thematic Stakeholder Workshops

Workshops are expected to produce **practical conclusions** which can assist in advancing on the objectives of the UfM Ministerial Declaration and **possibly lead to project ideas and proposals**.

Workshop proposals will be assessed against the following criteria:

- Regional dimension
- Effective contribution to one of the above list of topics;
- Interactive format;
- Innovative content and qualification of the foreseen speakers;
- Good geographical coverage and gender balance.
