"Architettura per i luoghi / Pica Ciamarra Associati" -an exhibition opened in 1987 by the Istituto Nazionale di Architettura in Rome / Palazzo Taverna with the support of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs- underwent several updatings and took place in a dozen of venues not only in Europe, complemented by the monograph Mondadori ed. with essays by Zevi, De Carlo, Klaus Koenig, Schimmerling, Nicoletti, Scaglione, Locci.

The Fondazione Mediterraneo -which since 2013 hosts "Utopia / Realtà" (among other things with the original 1/50 model of the nursery school and equipment in the historic center)- now promotes an exhibition in Naples of the PCAs to which Antonietta Iolanda Lima has dedicated the extensive monograph Jaca Book 2017: "From urban fragments to ecological systems - Architecture of the Pica Ciamarra Associati".

"Civilizing the urban" is the same title as the ETS born to spread a systemic vision of the transformations of living environments and also that of the collection of writings in "La Collection du CB" (200 pp./ 300 images / separate editions in French / English / Italian - www.lecarrebleu.eu- downloadable for free to celebrate the 60th anniversary of the CB).

The almost commanding tone of the terms highlights a possible utopia: it revolves around the substantial difference between "the city" and the "urbanized territories", around the logic of "the fragment", around the will to contribute to "the second nature targeted to civil uses"; it is in connection with the theme of the "city of dialogue" promoted by the Fondazione Mediterraneo with the Federazione Anna Lindh Italia onlus.

In the spaces of the Museum of Peace/ MAMT -an exceptional Wunderkammer collecting different art expressions and extraordinary records of the Mediterranean civilizations- "Civilizzare l'urbano" is a sequence of architectures mostly focused on videos: it extolls the diversity of the places housing it and develops in thematic rooms.

Among those one is devoted to the fourth environment and "Orbiecture", promoted by the Centre for Near Space / Italian Institute for the Future and another "Le Carré Bleu, feuille internationale d'architecture" which has influenced PCA's research since its beginning.

The research has influenced the attitude of PCAs in the same space with "A virtual trip within 50 years of design theory and practice".





