Short presentation

- AAM is an LGA operating in Albania, established 17 years ago with members the municipalities of Albania.
- AAM' operational structure is made of elected bodies and executive staff.
- Our focus is the consolidation of AAM as an independent organization in representing the interests of local government. Towards our membership the focus is consolidation of new municipalities coming from the Territorial Reform (61 new municipalities).
- As actively involved in process of territorial reform and other decentralization reforms, we have acquainted a vast experience and knowledge in local government and are recognized by those LGUs as an important support actor in training provision, lobbying, communication platform and establishing partnerships. ____



Overall Organizational Structure

- **General Assembly** composed of all Mayors and municipal councils, is the highest body of the Association.
- The Steering Committee leads the association's activity during the period between two General Assemblies. The Steering Committee is composed of the 15 members, that are Mayors with a geographical representation.
- **Professional Forums** composed of municipalities' representatives, specialists of areas as economy and local development, infrastructure and urban development, social affairs and education, legal and administrative issues, local finances, agriculture and land use, administrative units.
- Executive Staff composed of the Executive Director, appointed by the Steering Committee, Legal Officer and Finance Officer.



The main focus of work

- **Empowerment of AAM** as a stakeholder in decentralization. AAM is intended to serve as an educational and advocacy institution for Mayors and local elected officials, civil servants involved in the decentralization and EU-integration debate in Albania.
- **Knowledge enhancement** for Municipalities. The aim is to improve the delivery of newly-appointed tasks and responsibilities following major legal developments.
- Transparency and accountability enhancement addresses transparent and participatory municipal management as a tool to increase accountability of local politicians to their constituency.
- **Organizational development** to help improve municipal management, in addition to contributing to the discussion on the transfer of competencies to local government and the process of fiscal decentralization in Albania.
