AN APPEAL FOR THE COOPERATION OF ALL AGAINST COVID 19

In this particular historical moment, in which the whole world is involved in what could become a human tragedy - a desperate war against the invisible enemy *Covid 19* - everyone's cooperation is needed. The MEDITERRANEAN FOUNDATION, the MEDITERRANEAN ACADEMY, the MAISON DES ALLIANCES, the FORUM DE L'ACADEMIE POLITIQUE, the MUSEUM OF PEACE - MAMT, the MEDITERRANEAN OBSERVATORY ON ORGANIZED CRIME AND MAFIA together with other academic institutions, scientists and scientists from various countries launched today from Naples, Tunis, Rabat and other cities around the world

THE APPEAL FOR THE COOPERATION OF ALL AGAINST COVID 19.

The text underlines that **the vaccine is not and must not be a commodity** and that speculation is out of the question: **"to affirm this principle the cooperation of all is necessary and indispensable, in particular to help the weakest"**.

"Alongside rapid production and continuous experimentation - the text reads - the collaboration of every single individual is necessary. You cannot fight without defenses, if drugs and vaccines constitute the attack on the enemy, precautions and prudence are the defensive structures.

Social distancing, masks and hand hygiene are necessary bulwarks. However, these means are not enough to fight the war, as already said: a decisive strategy is needed, which in medicine is prevention".

The Appeal ends with a call for prevention to avoid further deaths through specific tests of the immune system and thrombophilia:

"Drugs and vaccines have side effects: the fact that these are limited does not mean that they can be ignored. Adequate prevention is necessary and take into account that:

Vaccines are based on the normal functioning of the immune system and, for this, prevention is essential through a preventive study of the immune system:

Specific investigations, such as lymphocyte typing, make it possible to comprehensively assess the state of the basic immune system.

The production of blood clots in some subjects, following vaccination, depends on the constitution of their blood: if you are genetically predisposed, the risk increases:

Specific investigations on thrombophilia - plasma and genetics - can identify patients at risk of developing arterial or venous thrombosis, who need particular attention both during Covid 19 disease and in the pre and post vaccination phase".

Said Margoul, Hayet Doghri, Ahmed Guerraoui, scientists and experts from various countries, members of the Fondazione Mediterraneo, the Accademia del Mediterraneo, the Maison des Alliances, the "Almamed" University Network, the Mediterranean Observatory on Organized Crime and the Mafias, of the "Euromedcity" Network of Cities, of the "Isolamed" and "Labmed" networks, of the Forum de l'Académie politique.
